#### Shopping centre drop offs and pickups

We take hundreds of clients to and from shopping centres within our funded area and it is becoming problematic finding safe drop off and pick up zones as well as finding clients when they go to the wrong pick-up spot.

For this reason, we have completed risk assessments and have identified one pickup and drop off spot at each major shopping centre. These locations were picked due to safety and accessibility.

Please do not ask drivers to drop you off elsewhere as they cannot.

#### Christmas Closedown Period

Please be aware, SWCT will be closing from 5pm on Friday 22 December 2023 and will re-open at 7am Tuesday 2nd of January 2024. We will not be delivering any transport during this period.

#### **CPI Price Rise**

As you are all very aware, the cost of living is not getting any cheaper and although we are Government funded, the funding does not cover anywhere near the costs we incur to deliver transport. We try our very best to keep the costs to you (the client) to a minimum but as of the 01/10/23 we have had to make the hard decision to raise our transport costs marginally.

Our new costs are:

Booking fee \$2

Cost per kilometre 65 cents

Minimum cost \$10 Maximum cost \$98

As usual we will load the whole cost onto the first leg of your journey to make payment easier.

If anyone is experiencing financial hardship, please call and ask to speak to Matthew and we will try to assist.

#### Identifying your belongings

We have over 6,000 active clients and transport hundreds of people every day. It would make things a lot easier or our drivers if you had name tags on your bulky items, like walkers and

walking sticks as well as your shopping bags. This would decrease the risk of your personal items or shopping going missing or accidentally being given to someone else.

#### Safety on our vehicles

Safety on our vehicles is everyone's responsibility. Team Members receive training to assist them in identifying and addressing safety risks during service provision, along with the most appropriate method to use when assisting clients.

Clients also have a responsibility to ensure their own safety and that of our Team Members.

#### Clients are asked to:

- At all times wear a seat belt when traveling on the vehicles and never remove your seatbelt before the vehicle has come to a complete stop.
- NEVER stand up when vehicle is in motion.
- · Wear flat and comfortable shoes.
- When leaving the vehicle PLEASE walk down the stairs backwards or sideways— this is the safest method of exiting— if you were to fall you would have the seats, rails or floor of the bus to reach out for and to minimise your injuries. If you are exiting forward and fall you only have the footpath and roadway to welcome you.
- At all times follow the instructions of the driver.
